


- 08:30 All PYP/MYP students gather by classes outside the main school entrance.

Message for PC Reps/Parent chaperones from each class:

1. Either PC reps or 2 volunteering parents from each class are to follow the parade. Lower PYP can have more. If you are not participating in the parade, please appoint 2 volunteering parents as “parent chaperones” to accompany the class.
2. Parent chaperones to take a headcount of your class at the beginning of the parade. (Classlist might come in handy.)
3. During the parade, parent chaperones to try to get your class to march in rows of five. We try to keep the formation plan as best as we can.
 - Note: To keep up with the formation plan, please tell the children not to accept Russe cards while in the parade. There will be plenty of opportunities after the parade
 - It is Norway’s birthday, we cheer at various points during the parade!
4. Do not stop at the end of the parade, but MARCH ON to the pick up point.
5. At the pickup point, PC reps/parent chaperones are to stay with your class children until they all have been collected. Pick up spot is in front of the dance school Step-by-Step, direction Bakke bro.
6. PC reps/Parent chaperones should have a few band-aids in their pockets, just in case. Also the lower classes tend to get restless while waiting at the designated waiting area. So have that in mind, and ask parents-in-charge to plan for it (have something to keep them occupied/snack).

Message to students/class parents:

1. *Usually Norwegian children wear the Norwegian traditional clothes ‘children’s bunad’ on this day. If you do not own one, please come dressed up or even wear the traditional clothes from your country. 😊😊
2. If you have the small handheld Norwegian flag, let your child bring it along.
3. **IMPORTANT: Please write your phone number on your child's arm in case of emergency**
4. Do not pick up your child during the parade or at the end of the parade, but at the designated pick up point.
5. At the designated pick up point, parents meet up with their children after the parade.

After-parade festivities:

For those who are interested both **Singsaker Skole** and **Bispehaugen skole** are having a Skolefest/familiefest organized by local marching band in the afternoon and begins at kl 16:00. Usually it starts with a performance from the marching band and there will be a small cafeteria, barbecue, games, fishing etc.
